Enter the 2009 Fairest of the Fair Contest

A. Listed below you will find instructions relative to the County Fairest of the Fair Contest, also the score card upon which the candidates will be judged in both the preliminary screening and final judging.

1. Preliminary Screening: *Time* 7:00 p.m. Thursday, August 13th; *Place* County Center Building. Come in street length dress. No guests or visitors allowed in building.

2. The scoring is based equally in the following categories:

- a. Personality and Attitude
- b. Maturity and Professionalism
- c. Speaking Ability
- d. Poise and Appearance
- e. Involvement and Activities
- f. Overall Impression

3. The ten (10) finalists will be selected Thursday night, August 13th.

4. Final judging of the ten (10) finalists will be judged at County Center at 7:00 p.m. Monday, August 17th. If for any reason you will not be present, please notify the Fair Office.

5. The five (5) members selected as the court from which the Fairest of the Fair will be chosen, will be notified.

B. Crowning

1. The judges will make their final decision at 8:30 on Wednesday evening August 19th.

2. The five court members will be introduced and the crowning of the Fairest of the Fair will take place on Wednesday night at 9:00 p.m. on the Free Act Stage.

3. The Fairest will keep the crown for one year, until the 2010 Fairest will be crowned.

4. The Fairest of the Fair will compete in January for State Fairest of the Fair.

C. Awards:

1. The Fairest will be awarded a life membership to the Kenosha County Fair.

2. The Five finalists selected for court will be given various gifts.
