The following are changes, additions, and/or substitutions that supersede the Premium Book valid for 2017 – 2018. Please read and be familiar with any potential changes that would affect a Department you plan to exhibit in.

GENERAL FAIR INFORMATION CHANGES:

Page 6 - #8 – Animals and articles will remain at the Fair from the date of entry through the close of the Fair. No articles will be removed from the Fair property before 7PM (walk out only). Vehicles will be allowed on the grounds as of 8PM on the Sunday of the Fair to remove animals/articles. Junior Fair exhibits should be picked up before 9PM on Sunday. Open Class articles should be picked up before 9PM on Sunday or the Monday following the Fair from 9AM – 11AM. Any exhibits not picked up will become the property of the Kenosha County Fair and will be disposed of after October 1st.

Only one entry per person will be allowed. Painting must be framed and wired for hanging. All other rules of Open Class Department 118 will apply (see page 26 of Fair Book). The entry should be made under Department 118, Division C – Amateurs, Class # 19 – High School Student oil, acrylic or mixed media painting.

JUNIOR DEPARTMENT 2 – BEEF CATTLE

MARKET BEEF

All steers must be weighed on Wednesday from 2 – 4PM. Exhibitors should enter each animal in correct breed divisions. Include ear tag number of entry form. Weight classes will be determined after all steers are weighed. Market beef will be shown according to the following rules:

Rules:

1. Grooming equipment: Each exhibitor will be allowed a rice brush, a curry comb, a scotch comb, clippers, blower and one grooming chute.
2. Grooming materials: Final bloom only for showing and selling
3. There will be no hair limit, adhesives or paint will not be allowed.

JUNIOR DEPARTMENT 6 – HORSE AND PONY

General Rules:

G. All horses and ponies will be kept on the Fairgrounds for the duration of the Fair. Horseless Horse buddies supporting the Horse project may be excluded from the mandatory barn housing rule (approval must be requested to Superintendents prior to January 1 of the project year.

Class # 21. Alumni – open to anyone who was, at one time, a member of the 4H Dog Project. Exhibition only, no premiums will be awarded.

Division: D – RALLY OBEDIENCE Class # 4. Alumni – open to anyone who was, at one time, a member of the 4H Dog Project. Exhibition only, no premiums will be awarded.
