Rules:

1. Demo Derby will be run as “last man standing” until 3 combines are left. The Top 3 will be judged to determine 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>.
2. Battery and Gas tanks need to be relocated into the hopper of the machine.
3. No fluid is allowed in the tires.
4. Head should be rigid mounted 18 – 21 inches off the ground. Heads can be braced with a maximum of 4 x 4 square tubing at 45° from feeder house but not to exceed the outside of the front tires. (NO Exceptions!)
5. If a combine is dead for more than 90 seconds, they have the opportunity to re-enter the demo. However, they will forfeit their ability to place in the top 4.

6. Drivers can do anything to the driver's cab to make it safer for the driver.
7. Steering lines can be re-routed to prevent damage.
8. All drivers will be required to wear helmets and eye protection.
9. All drivers will be required to remove their equipment after the demolition derby is complete.
10. All drivers will be required to wear an ear-piece that will be supplied the night of the demo derby. This will allow for one-way communication between the drivers and person in charge to help with safety for drivers and workers.
11. All decisions made by the Fair Board are final.
12. In 2021, the intention is to run two nights of Combine Derby. There will be a random drawing of which combines will run on Wednesday and which combines will run on Thursday. The goal is to have a minimum of 10 combines on each night. Entry forms are due to the Fair Office by August 2, 2021.
