Rules:

- 1. Demo Derby will be run as "last man standing" until 3 combines are left. The Top 3 will be judged to determine 1st, 2nd and 3rd.
- 2. Battery and Gas tanks need to be relocated into the hopper of the machine.
- 3. No fluid is allowed in the tires.
- Head should be rigid mounted 18 21 inches off the ground. Heads can be braced with a maximum of 4 x 4 square tubing at 45° from feeder house but not to exceed the outside of the front tires. (NO Exceptions!)
- 5. Hydrostatic drives are allowed.
- 6. Diesel or gas combines are allowed.

- 7. If a combine is dead for more than 90 seconds, they have the opportunity to re-enter the demo. However, they will forfeit their ability to place in the top 4.
- 8. Drivers can do anything to the driver's cab to make it safer for the driver.
- 9. Steering lines can be re-routed to prevent damage.
- 10. All drivers will be required to wear helmets and eye protection.
- 11. All drivers will be required to remove their equipment after the demolition derby is complete.
- 12. All drivers will be required to wear an ear-piece that will be supplied the night of the demo derby. This will allow for one-way communication between the drivers and person in charge to help with safety for drivers and workers.
- 13. All decisions made by the Fair Board are final.
- 14. Entry forms are due to the Fair Office by August 11th, 2023.
